### Description:

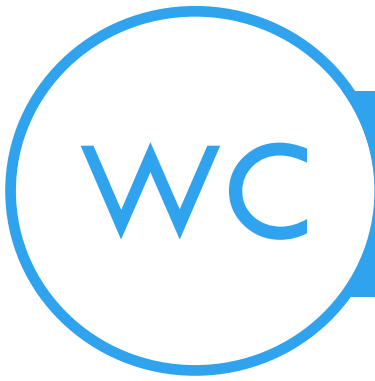
This project was done as a concept design to show a modern, sleek and easy to use one-page style website for a coffee shop / café type business.

This project was done as a concept design for a DJ business.

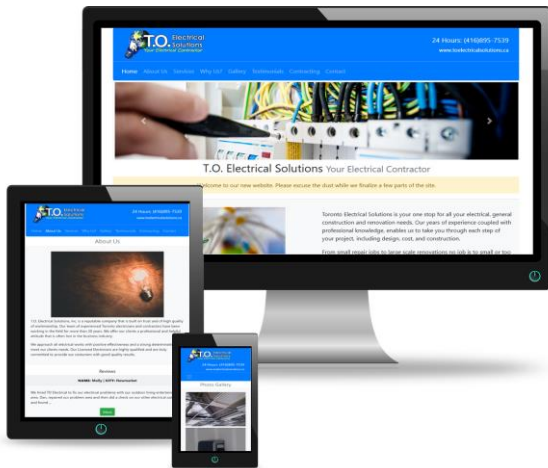
The site concept was designed in HTML with the use of jQuery, Bootstrap and custom JavaScript functions.

**Description:**

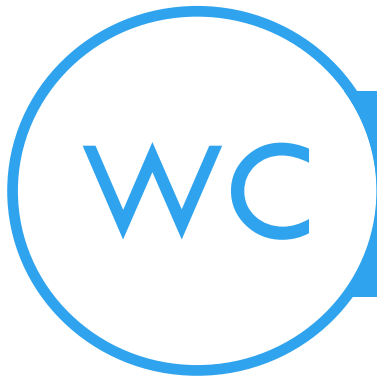
A website for a small electrical business located in the Toronto area.

The site was custom designed, utilizing bootstrap for a responsive design.

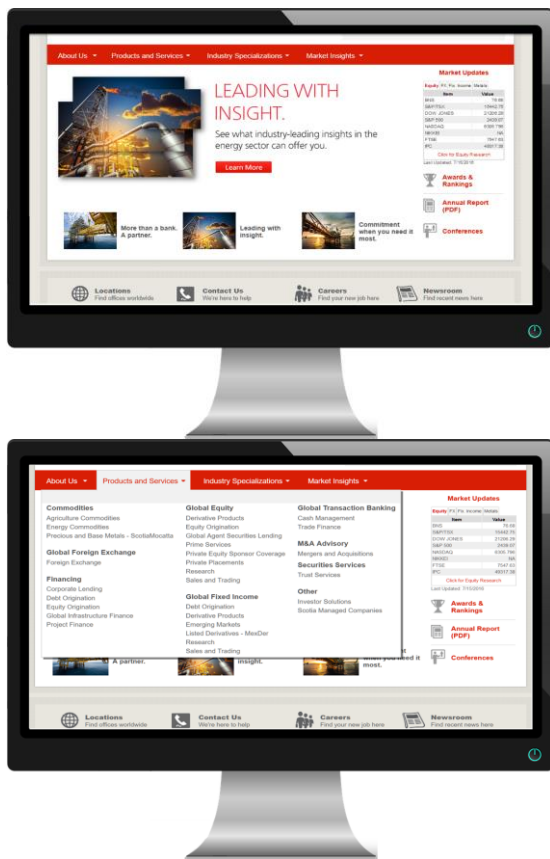
Some of the custom coded features of the site include a gallery function, a database driven back end for content management and mobile friendly design.

## PROJECT: SCOTIABANK GLOBAL BANKING AND MARKETS (2016-2017)



### Description:

The existing Scotiabank Global Banking and Markets website (as well as the company's other properties) were designed several years ago and had a dated web design and look.

I worked with the marketing team at the bank, along with the main Scotiabank web team to redesign the sites to match the newly launched redesign of the main Scotiabank website.

The project was a large one which took over a year to complete, as it involved redesigning the main Global Banking and Markets site, along with the other companies that ran under its umbrella, including Scotia FX, Scotia Mocatta, Scotia Prime Finance, Scotiabank Brazil, Scotiabank Colombia, Scotiabank Japan and others.
